



Recycling is as old as man - much of the wealth of the past has been melted and reformed many times as the tastes for displaying such items has altered.

Today, we have the wealth of metal, wood, glass, plastics and petroleum being recycled by farsighted businesses to keep as much as possible of yesterday's valuable materials and to enjoy the fruits of resources and energy that are not being expended.

Garbage companies are the labor source for much of our recycling. Most areas have free pickup of separated material and all junk and salvage yards play an important roll.

Garbage haulers began a monthly curbside service four years ago (locally it is weekly). Nationally 150 million tons of waste a year, provide 11 million pounds of recyclable materials to be removed from our waste destined for dumpsites.
