At the February meeting, Bob Grosch gave an excellent presentation on Plate Varieties on U.S. Engraved issues. Elements of the presentation included how engraved stamps are created by hand engraving and how the engravings are transferred from engraved dies to the printing plates; layout lines used in the die transfer process, how the paper picks up ink from the plate; and how all these transfer processes can produce plate varieties.

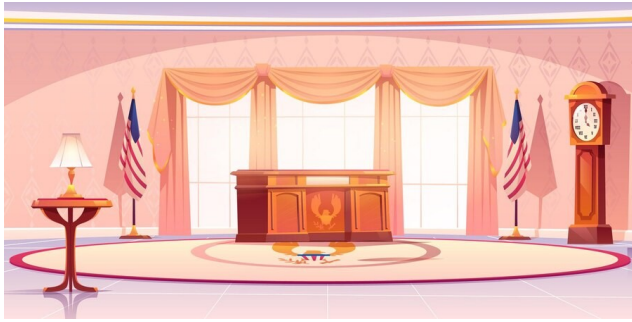
March 2024 Meeting.


Thirdly, the Evergreen Spring Stamp Show is on April 20—21 at Kent Commons, 525 4th Ave N, Kent, WA.

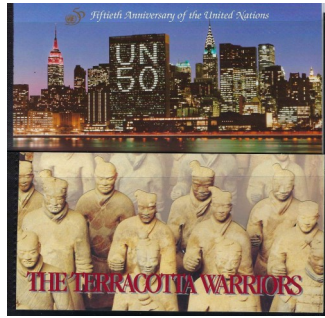

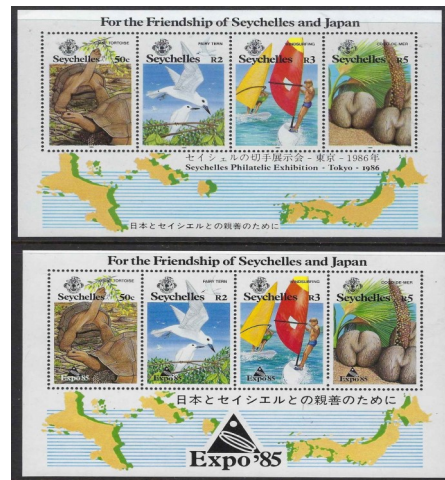
