Monthly Newsletter

Members receive our monthly newsletter either by post or by e-mail. Newsletter contain interesting articles, complete listing of offerings on monthly bid boards and current and future stamps shows throughout the Pacific Northwest.

BID BOARD & AUCTIONS

Seven months a year the Salem Stamp Society presents a bid board for members to peruse and bid on philatelic material to enhance their collections. The bid board showcases approximately seventy items which includes single stamps or sets both US and worldwide. A minimum bid is listed and a silent auction continues until the bid is closed.

Twice a year the club holds an exciting oral auction of club owned material which includes stamps, covers, albums, collections and other philatelic material.

Additionally, twice a year the club sponsors a members auction where members may auction any philatelic material they choose.

Frequent auctions help members with their collections at a substantial savings. The club regularly buys stamps and collections to put up for the membership to bid on.

PHILATELIC LIBRARY

Our library has an extensive collection of philatelic material spanning more than seventy years which is available for all members to use, including a complete set of Scott catalogs. Books can be checked out for up to one month.

HOLIDAY DINNER

Our annual Holiday Dinner in December is a special social occasion for members and their spouses and includes a philatelic and non philatelic drawing.
